

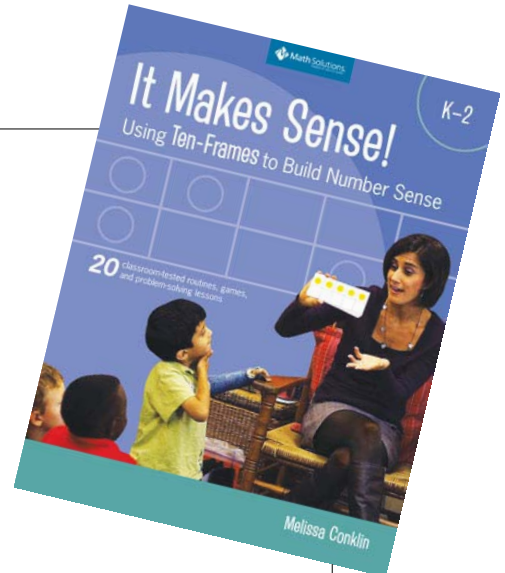
# Mathematics Book Study K-2
