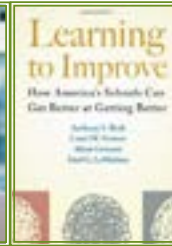
Don't miss this FREE opportunity to build improvement capacity and collaborate with other district teams around this important topic.
