## PLC Deep Dive: Essential Questions

### Questions 1 & 2: Monday, October 15th

Join us to take a deep dive into two of the PLC essential questions. Structured protocols engage participants in collaboratively exploring the questions “What do we want students to learn?” and “How do we empower each and every student in relevant learning?” Learn to build coherence in instructional learning goals and address 21st century skills with attention to college/career readiness within the framework of PLCs. Additional topics include taking a proactive rather than reactive approach toward planning that meets the needs of ALL students, and incorporating universal design for learning principles into the PLC process.



### Questions 3 & 4: Wednesday, January 9th

In this workshop, participants will take a deeper look into two of the essential PLC questions. In collaboratively exploring the questions “How do we document the learning process?” and “How do we respond if students do/don’t learn?” participants will learn strategies to both collect multiple measures of quantitative and qualitative data, and also analyze this information to drive instructional planning to best meet the needs of students. Learn to leverage the PLC framework to focus on student learning in a holistic way that goes beyond a single measure.
