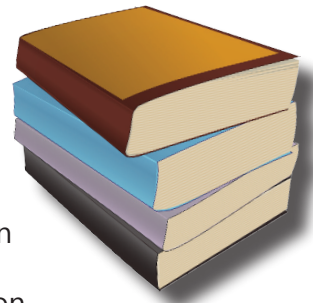

- Strengthen the teaching you do during a nonfiction reading unit by bringing nonfiction read-alouds to life



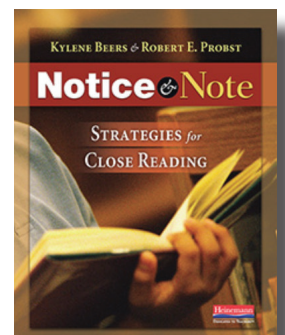
This workshop will be punctuated by opportunities to experience non-fiction reading work firsthand and explore how students skills progress as thinking and texts become more complex.
