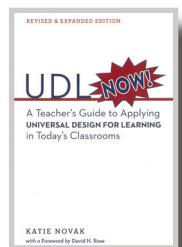
## Universal Design for Learning

**“Universal design for learning (UDL) is a framework to improve and optimize teaching and learning for all people based on scientific insights into how humans learn.” - CAST INSTITUTE**

Grounded in the research at CAST, Tulare County Office of Education brings you this workshop series.

### UDL 101: The Foundation

This workshop dives deep into understanding the conceptual framework behind Universal Design for Learning. It is a day dedicated to the why and how of the framework. Explore the concept of learner variability and the connection between UDL, differentiation and multi-tiered systems of support (MTSS). Walk away with an understanding of the purpose of UDL and how to break down barriers for all students, including English Learners and students with exceptional needs, to access learning.



**At the conclusion of day one, we encourage you to inform your UDL facilitator if you will attend UDL 201 or 202 for your day two.**

### UDL 201: Instructional Design

In this workshop, learn how the UDL framework guides the design of instructional goals, assessments, methods, and materials by customizing your lesson plans and designing instruction to meet the needs of ALL learners.

### UDL 202: Leading UDL

This workshop provides a systems view of Universal Design for Learning, and will provide structured collaboration time for you to apply this understanding to your context.
