
Ticket Booth: Food for Thought



Materials

- 8 copies of trivia questions* (See **Trivia Questions** section.)
- 4–8 chairs
- 1 table
- “Power Up!” tickets (enough for 10 per child)
- canopy (optional, strongly recommended in hot weather)
- 4–8 volunteers
- 4–8 cones, one per volunteer



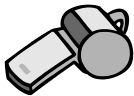
Prep Time

10 minutes



Setup

1. Place this booth in the center of all the activity stations. It should be like the center of a clock.
2. Set up the shade structure.
3. Put a table with 6–8 chairs around it. Turn the chairs so they are facing away from the table.
4. Place a cone about 6 feet in front of each chair.
5. Put tickets and sets of trivia questions for each volunteer on the table, so volunteers can easily reach them.



Directions

- Have students form lines at any cone in front of the volunteers.
- Volunteer calls the first student in line to come forward to answer a trivia question.
- After the student answers a question, the volunteer gives the student one “Power Up!” ticket, which allows the student to go participate at one of the activity stations.



Helpful Hints

- Have teachers or adults who best know the students volunteer at this station.
- Have bilingual teachers or staff at this station to help non-English speakers.
- Explain to students that they must come back and answer another question each time before they can participate in another activity.
