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Tulare County Office of Education Announces:

Special Services Program Seeks Part-Time Instructional Assistants

Tulare County Office of Education's Special Services Division has openings for numerous Instructional Assistants to work with students in its Severely Handicapped programs. Candidates must have successfully completed 48 hours of college courses, or be able to pass a proficiency exam. Candidates must also have the ability to frequently lift 26 to 50 pounds and the flexibility to sit alongside students on the floor. Instructional Assistants work three to three and a half hours per day assisting students with motor activities, communication exercises, daily living skills and grooming. Positions are available throughout Tulare County on school campuses, or at one of the Tulare County Office of Education's Learning Centers.
