Tulare County Head Start child chosen for national commemorative campaign

Visalia - Alejandra Cortez-Andrade, a preschooler at the Washington Child Care Center in Lindsay, has been selected as one of five children nationwide to represent the federal Head Start program's service milestone of 25 million children enrolled. She was the only child selected for the campaign from California.

Head Start's commemorative campaign is promoting its success in preparing children for school and helping to close the achievement gap once students are in elementary school. Alejandra began the program as a child who wouldn't speak at school. According to Angie Rodriguez-Angeles, supervisor at the Washington Center, Alejandra's teachers have worked to get her to repeat things they say and to do things in front of the class. Today, her speech is perfect and she is very motivated to read. Alejandra's progress at her Head Start program has inspired her mother to further her own education and acquire better English skills.
