Next week, kindergarten through eighth-grade students will display their writings at the annual Young Authors' Faire. For the event, students write, illustrate and bind their stories for the public to read. The books are on display for the week of March 15 in the Education Center of the Tulare County Office of Education. During the week, visitors are invited to read and comment on the books. Two evening receptions will be held from 4:00 to 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, March 16 and Thursday, March 18, so that the public can meet the young authors and celebrate their successes. As an added feature this year, student authors will give a brief reading from their books at these receptions.

“The Young Authors’ Faire challenges students in many areas,” says Tulare County Superintendent of Schools Jim Vidak. “In developing and reading their own books, students are using a variety of language arts and visual arts skills.” The authors’ works will be available for viewing beginning at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, March 15.
