Patty Siegel, founder and executive director of the California Child Care Resource & Referral Network, will be the keynote speaker at the 14th Annual Child Care Conference on Saturday, April 6 from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Visalia Convention Center. Siegel spoke at the White House Conference on Child Care in the late 90's and advocated for expanded child care funding at the federal level.
