Drew Dudley is redefining leadership with his Day One process. His TED talk "Everyday Leadership (The Lollipop Moment)" was voted "one of the 15 most inspirational TED talks of all time" and has more than five million views globally. In 2018, Drew shared his story and the Day One process in his book, *This is Day One: A Practical Guide to Leadership That Matters.* Drew credits the Day One process with saving his life after struggling with undiagnosed bipolar disorder and the challenges of a career that kept him on the road 250 days a year. Recognizing how many people are struggling silently with similar battles, Drew infuses these experiences into his keynotes, hoping to remind people that their scars in no way stand in the way of their leadership.
