The degree of risk depends upon the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized." "If within 24 hours following application you experience symptoms similar to common seasonal illness comparable to the flu, contact your physician or poison control center (800-876-4766) and your pest control company immediately."

If rodenticide ingestion occurs, you may experience symptoms of mild shock and/or bleeding. (Anticoagulant reaction)
