The abundant rain, which drenched California several weeks ago, has produced a rare learning opportunity for Tulare County students. The vernal pools at the Circle J-Norris Ranch field study site are now full.

Amanda Driver, lead teacher at Circle J, is encouraging teachers to contact her to arrange a visit to the field study site. Students of all ages – from elementary through community college – are welcome to attend and utilize available lessons or work with Driver to create research of their own.

Another way teachers can enjoy the learning opportunities at Circle J-Norris Ranch is by registering to attend the annual Field Science Day on Friday, February 17. The Field Science Day is open to classes of middle and high school students, and community college students. At the event, students will conduct original research and collect data on vernal pool ecosystems, measure water levels, and monitor the animals that depend on the pools.

Dr. Douglas Reeves and team to conduct Fearless Schools Summit March 1

Leadership Support Services and Educational Resource Services will host Dr. Douglas Reeves and a team of consultants from Creative Leadership Solutions for a full-day Fearless Schools Summit on March 1. The summit is based on Dr. Reeves' book, "Fearless Schools: Building Trust and Resilience for Learning, Teaching, and Leading." The core of fearless schools, Dr. Reeves explains, is psychological safety. In this interactive presentation, he explains how leaders and teachers build and maintain trust and psychological safety. Special attention will be paid to resilience –



bouncing back from physical, emotional, and psychological injury.

Following Dr. Reeve's keynote presentation, participants will have the opportunity to attend breakout sessions led by members of his team. Topics include Engagement Strategies for Inclusion, Multi-Tiered System of Support for SEL, Power of PLCs, and Creating Inclusive Classrooms.
