- Engage in strategies for solidifying student learning through learning maps, lesson consolidation, and meaningful notes

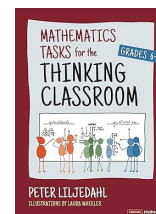
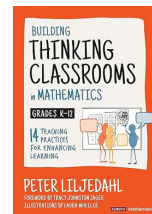
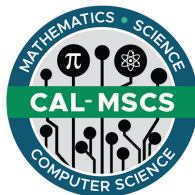
