Student Booms

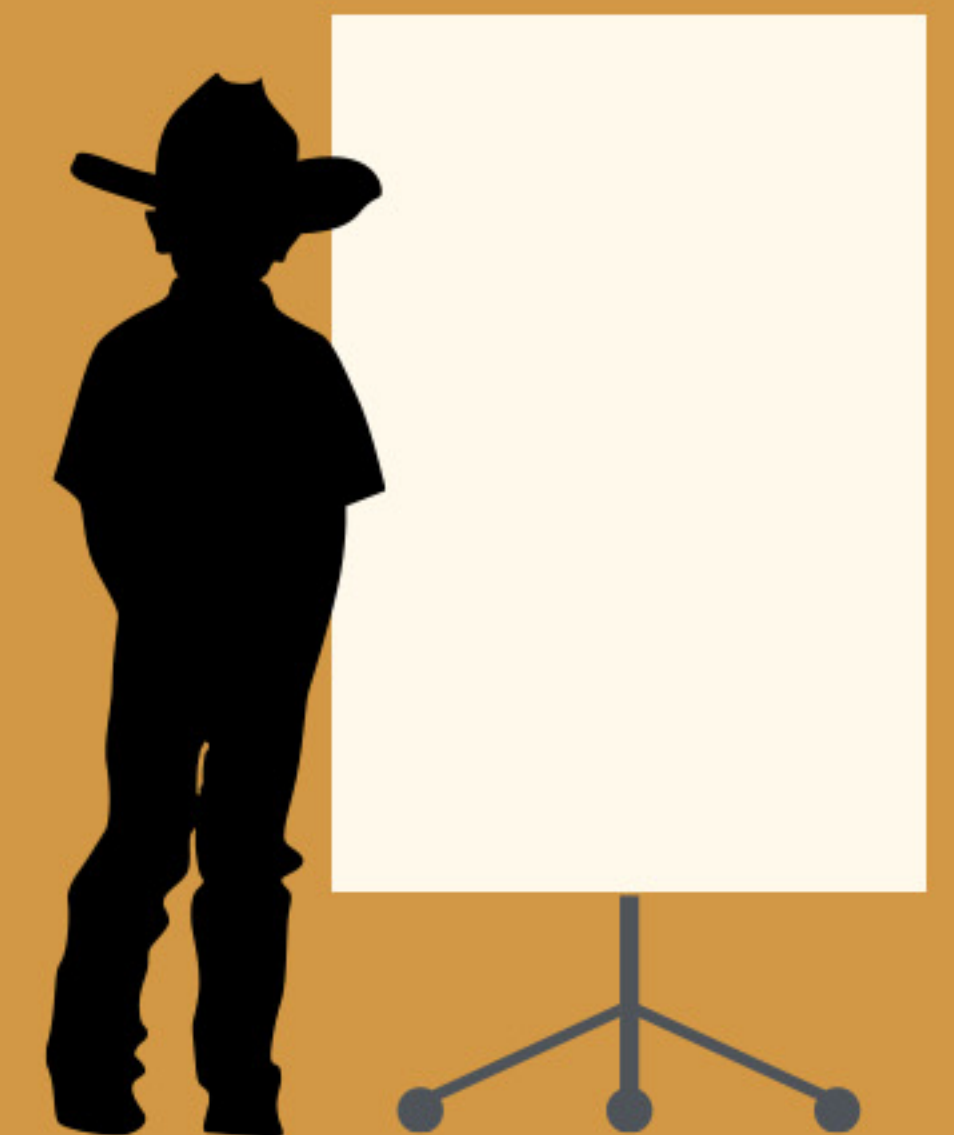
