What is LETRS Training?

The LETRS® (Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and Spelling) Suite is a comprehensive professional learning designed to provide educators with deep knowledge to be literacy and language experts. Developed by Dr. Louisa Moats and leaders in the field of literacy, LETRS teaches the skills needed to master the foundations and fundamentals of reading and writing instruction – phonological awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, comprehension, and written language.

What is a TCOE cohort?

Participants in a district cohort will complete LETRS Volume 1 and 2 over the course of two years. Participants must commit to attending all eight end-of-unit, in-person sessions as well as online work, independent reading, and a bridge to practice during the school year.

Who can participate?

This cohort is open to K–6 teachers, literacy coaches, administrators, special education teachers, and TOSAs.
