



# iLead Preliminary Administrative Services Credential Program

The mission of the iLead Administrative Services Credential Program is to develop educational leaders with vision.

## PASC Program Info

The iLead Preliminary Administrative Services Credential Program is an innovative program that integrates a blend of theoretical practice conjoined with an authentic 20-day fieldwork assignment, which fosters a practical learning experience for candidates wanting to become an education leader.

## Opportunity

Candidates engage in rich conversations and rigorous learning through coursework aligned to the California Administrator Performance Expectations (CAPEs).

## Structure

Through a cohort structure over the course of 12 months, assigned groups will learn together and support each other through content-based experiences, project-based activities, and ongoing reflective leadership goal setting. Classes are held two or three nights per week via in-person, online, or hybrid models.

## Support

Staff assistance is provided to complete required documents and to access materials and technology. Mentoring of candidates is done by experienced practitioners through a 20-day field work assignment, allowing candidates to bridge coursework to authentic leadership practice.

## Experience

Twenty-Day authentic fieldwork component (four of which are non-student attendance days). Candidates develop and refine leadership skills by working hands-on with local site administrators who will guide and mentor leadership development across the administrative leadership standards.

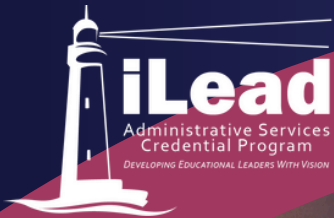

## Program Eligibility Requirements

- Bachelor's degree (official transcripts)
- Possess a valid clear/life California designated subjects teaching credential or valid clear/life California services credential
- Five years of successful, full-time experience in a school setting
- Program application
- Letter of introduction
- Resume
- Recommendation of current site administrator
- Recommendation of other administrator
- Two letters of recommendation
- District approval

## Program Completion/Exit Criteria

- Five years of successful, full-time experience in a school setting
- All program requirements met



# iLead Clear Administrative Services Credential Program

## Experience

Candidates have both a high level of independence and responsibility as they develop their leadership skills through the two-year program. Participants utilize job-embedded work as an opportunity to put theory into action and build educational leadership skills and best practices.

## Opportunity

Candidates engage in personalized learning that is driven by coaching and professional development to foster the creation of a Professional Leadership Community through the exchange of ideas, best practices, and experiences.
