Yokuts Acorn Processing: Students gather fallen acorns under oaks trees and learn to process acorn into food as the Yokuts did each fall. Students learn about the similarities and differences between people of today and the people of the past by studying food, customs, and lifestyles. **History-SS Standard K.6-3**

Seed Travels: Students gather dried seeds and use magnifiers to examine the seeds. They discuss how wind, animals and water disperse seeds and then categorize them into modes of travel: Hook, Yum-yum, Floater and parachute seeds.

Science Standards 4 b, d & e

Acorn Woodpeckers: Students learn that insects are the summertime food and acorns are wintertime food for acorn woodpeckers. They gather and place acorns into a granary. They count how many woodpecker holes there are in a fencepost.

Science Standards 3 b

Pond & Stream: Students gather pond water and use magnifiers to examine the tiny creatures living in it! They identify legs, head, thorax, abdomen, antennae and wing buds on the animal's bodies. They describe similarities and differences in the appearance and behavior of the aquatic creatures. **Science Standards 2 a & c**
